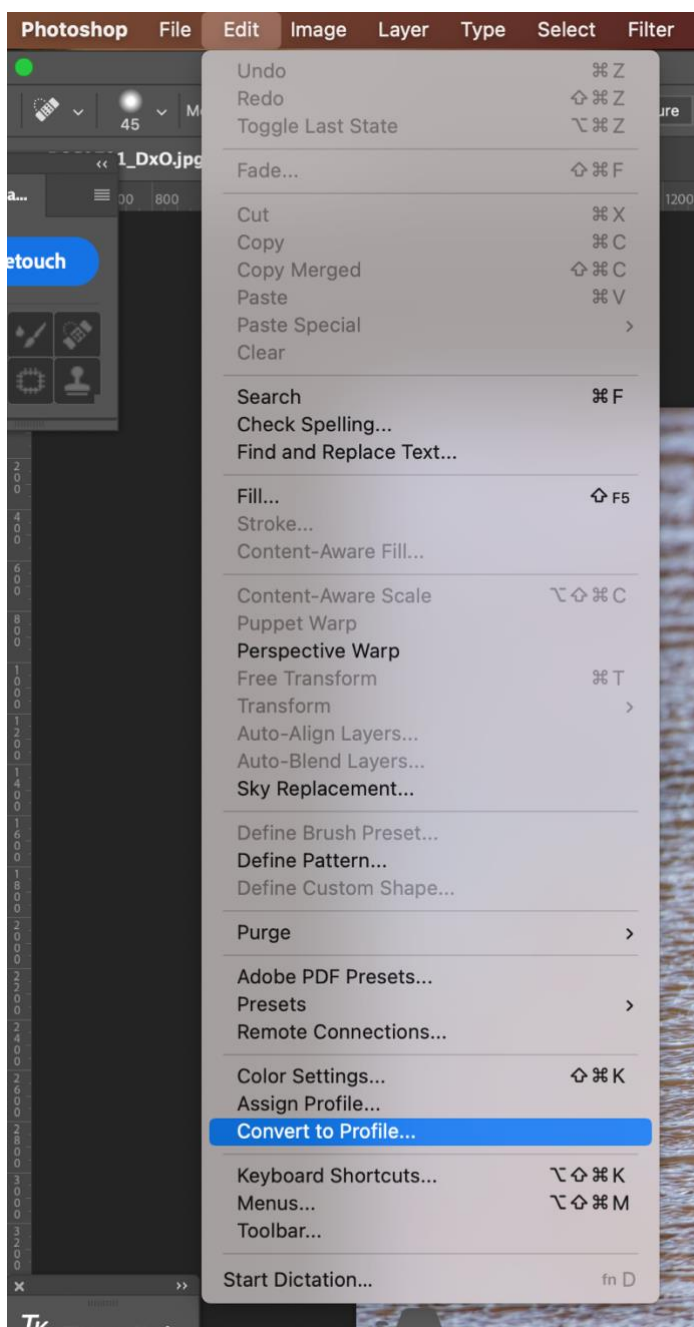

Image Resize and Colour Profile for displaying on web and projectors

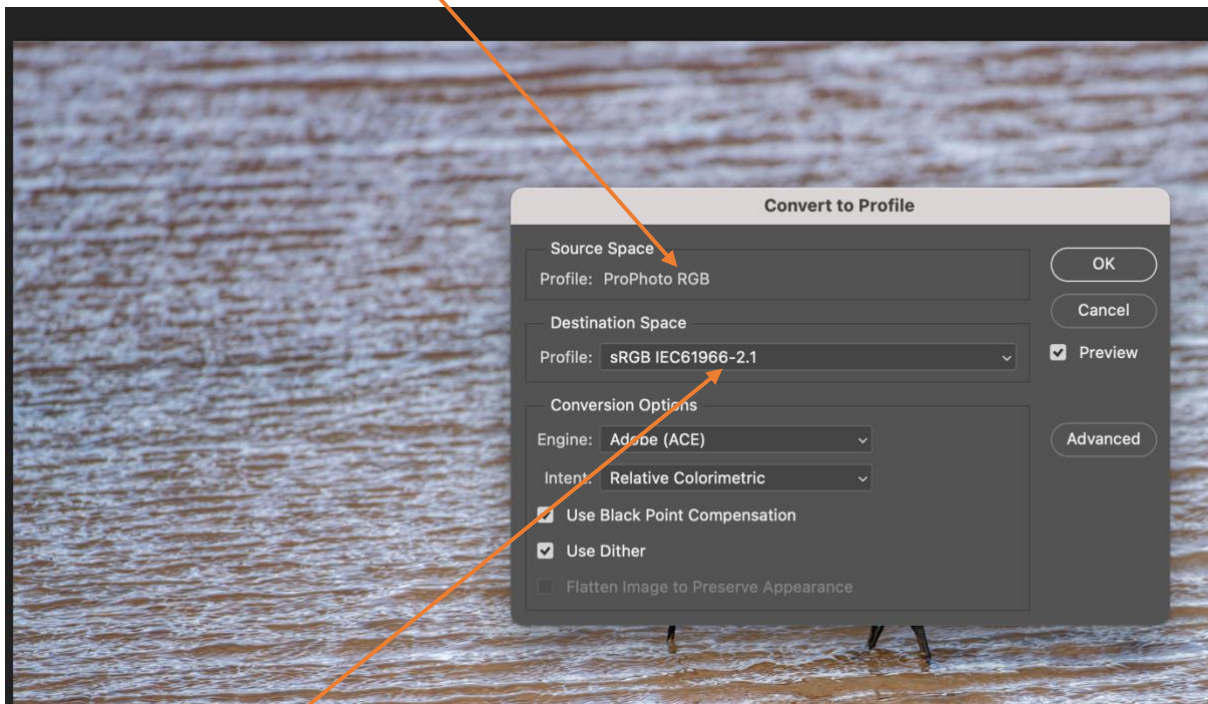
After all edits and before saving

1 Convert to sRGB Profile as this offers the best colour rendition on the web and screens

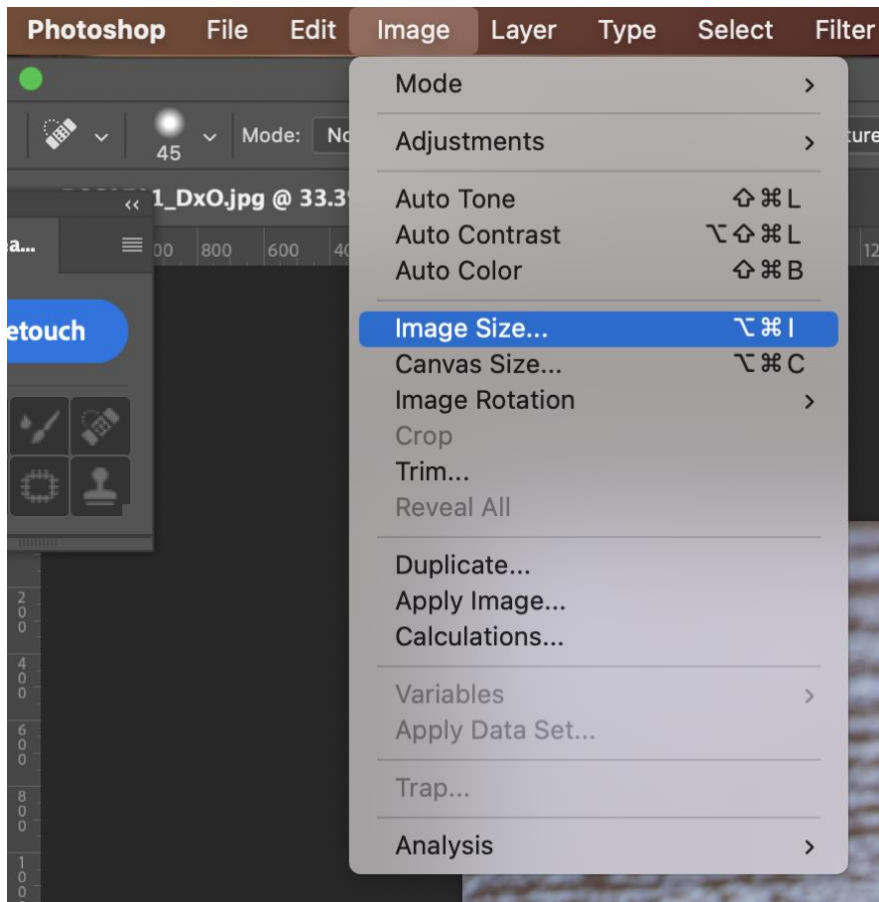


2. This shows was in ProPhoto



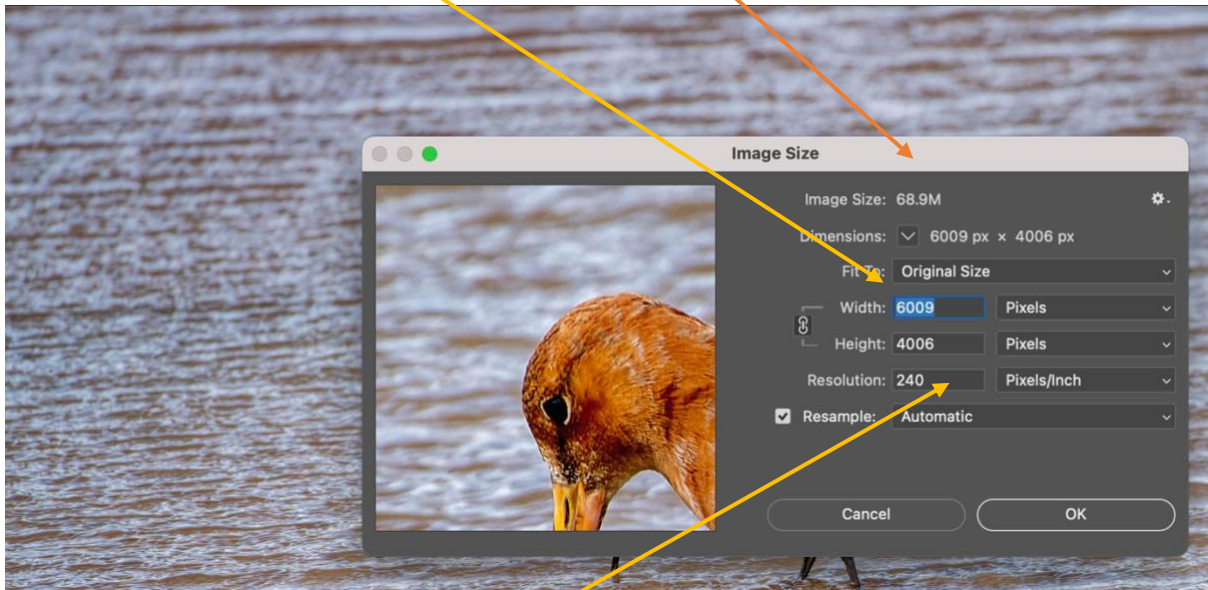

Resize options

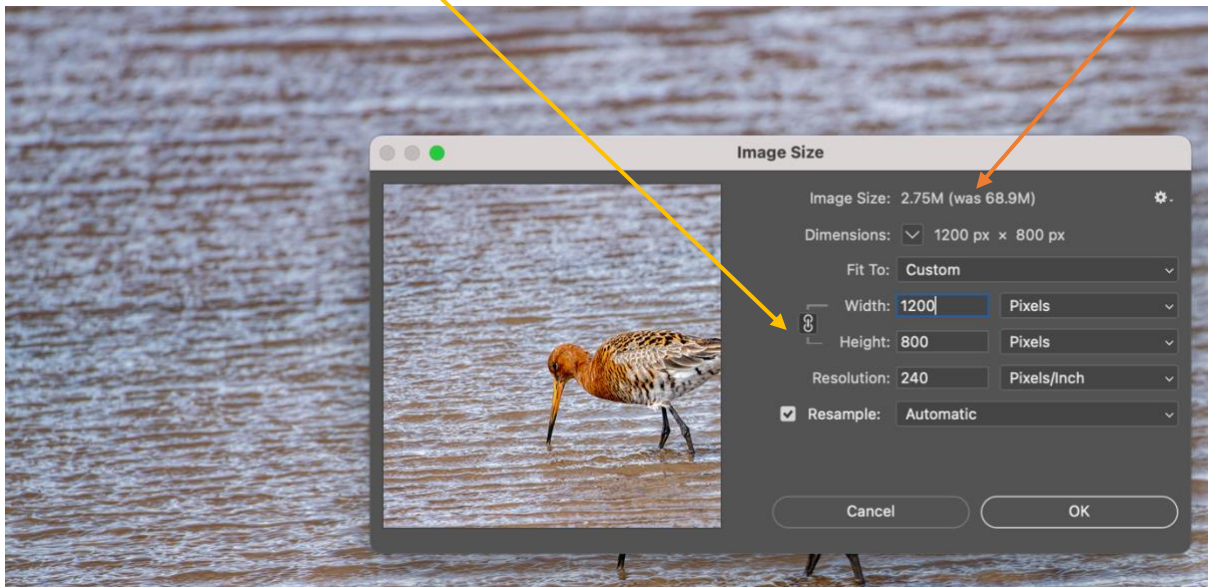
Original initial Image 6009 pixels. And size is mb 68.9



Resolution can be kept around 240dpi

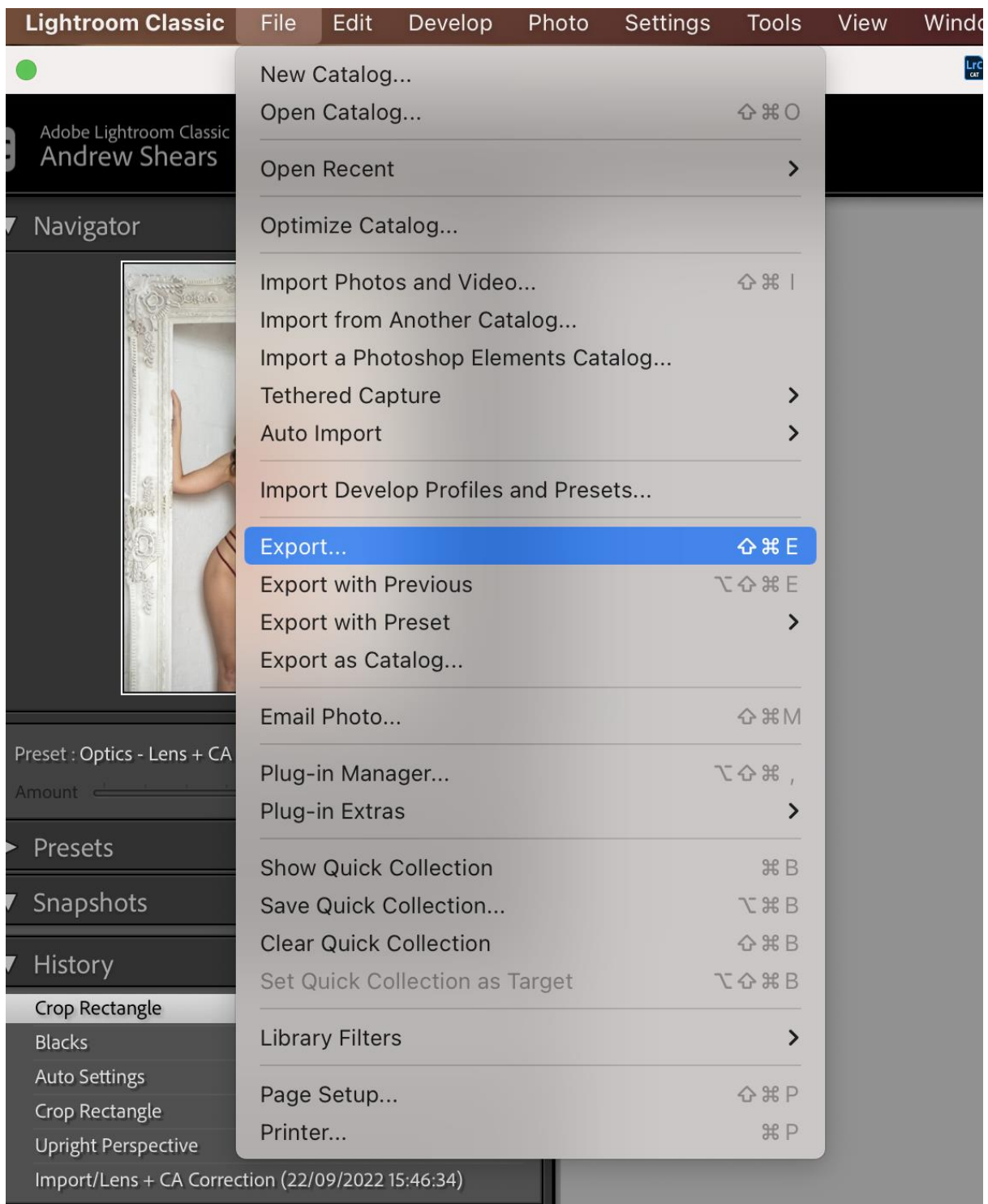
Resize to 1200px on the longest side ensure the link bars are on for Ratio being kept the same

Check Size is around 3mb



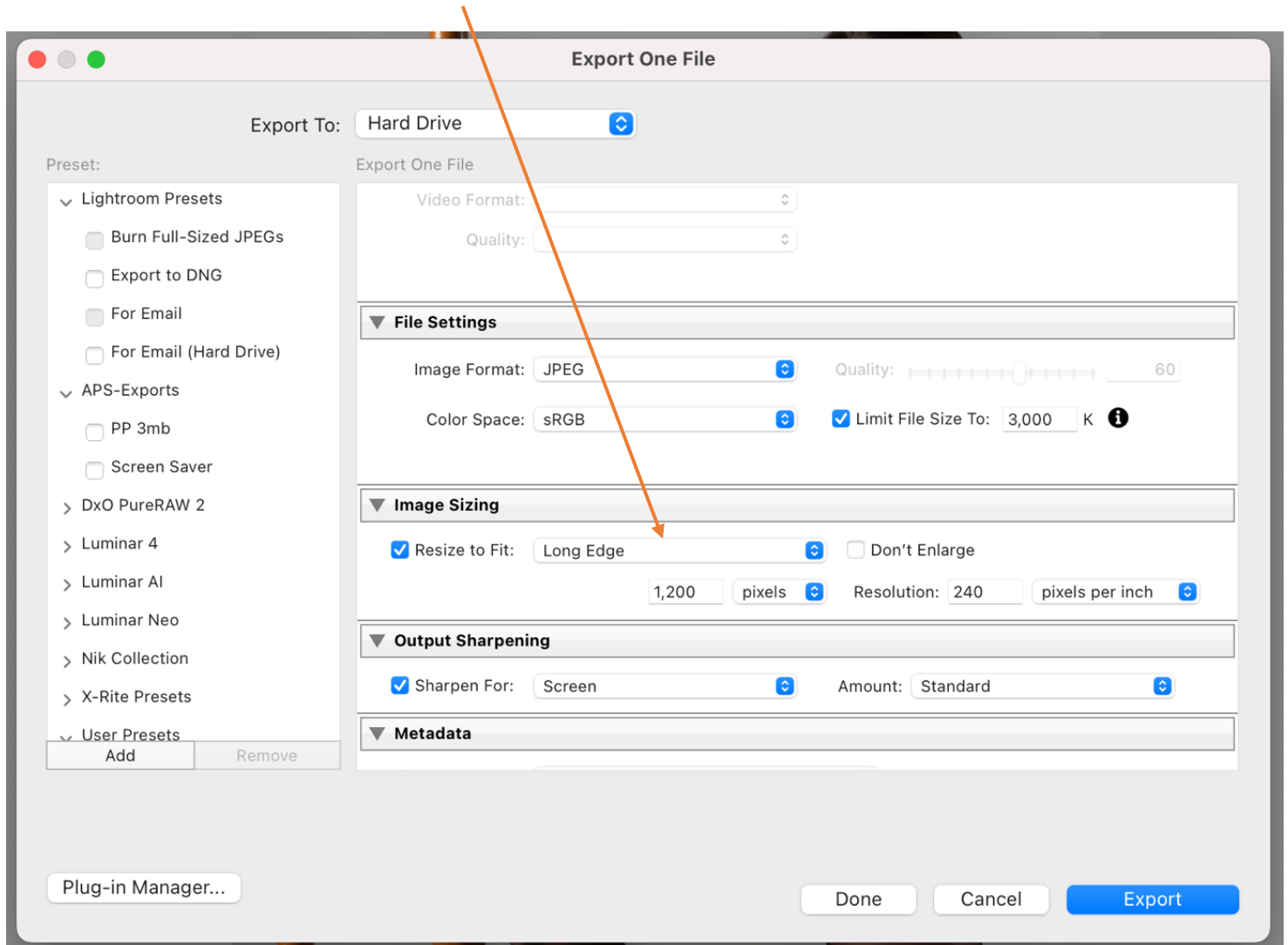
LIGHTROOM

Just use Export



Set images to jpg and colour space as sRGB in File Settings
Limit File Size to 3000K

Image sizing to 1200 on longest size and Resolution 240 dpi

With photo open apply the following:

1. Image> Convert Colour profile> Remove Profile>
2. Image> Convert Colour Profile> Convert to sRGB Profile
3. Then you go to Image> Resize> Image Size as with the others
4. Tick constrain proportions and number of pixels 1200 on the longest edge.
